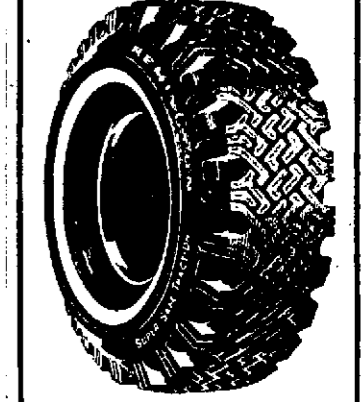


Classic Surprise

Combining games of 242, 253, and 244, the 33-year-old bowler topped his high series total for 12 years of competition.

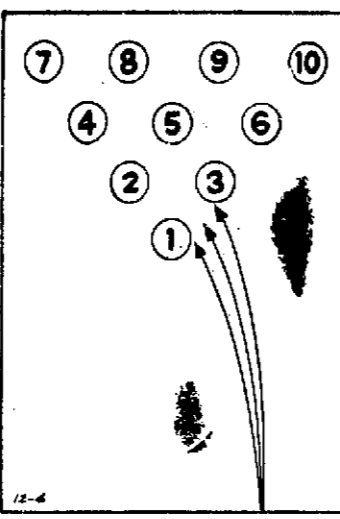

WHY THE HOOK?

If you're wondering, ladies, why the hook ball is the best one to roll, here's the reason. The hook gives the bowler a bigger 1-3 pocket to hit. More tolerance from a less-than-perfect hit is given. High hits (closer to the head pin) and thin hits (closer to the 3-pin) have a better chance of striking than a straight or curve ball.
