All qualifiers in the district meet qualify for the State State Meet.

DRESSING FACILITIES:

Contestants should dress at home, school, or hotel. Dressing space is not available at the Club House at the Golf Course.

EATING AND LODGING:

All Teams must make their own arrangements for eating and housing. The eating facilities of the University, Ohio Union and Pomerene Hall are open to all coaches and contestants.

PRACTICE:

Any teams or individuals may inspect the course after noon Thursday, anytime Friday or before the meet on Saturday.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Additional information and contestants: numbers may be picked up downstairs of the pro shop at the golf course after Noon Friday or Saturday morning. All contestants must be accompanied by a faculty representative of the school they are competing for.

FOOTBALL GAME:

The Ohio State University football game with Illinois is is at Illinois.

SUGGESTIONS:

We wish to improve the caliber of the meet to provide the best for each team and contestant. Any suggestions or constructive criticisms are always welcome and should be directed to: Bob Epskamp, 410 W. Woodruff, Columbus, Ohio 43210.

CONTESTANTS:

Wear your number on the front of your running jersey. First Call will be given 15 min. before the race. At that time, all runners should report to the clerk at the starting line. Find your assigned lane and clerk will get around to check you.

LAST CALL

LAST CALL will be given at 5 min. before the race. At that time, all runners must be in their assigned lanes. Do not remove sweat clothes until told to do so by start COURSE:

The distance to the first turn in the course is 750 yard: yards.

Each ½ mile is marked. The mile is just before you start up the hill.

Run to the limed side of all red and yellow flags.

Yellow - Right

Red - Left

Blue - Straight

If a contestant is uncertain of the course, he should walk or jog over it sometime before the race. There will be inspectors at all major turns.

- 1. All coaches pick up your packets with numbers and information concerning the meet at Station 1 at the basement of the Pro Shop and complete the expense form.
- 2. Give the names of your entries to the clerk at Station 2.
- 3. As your men finish and move quickly through the chute, their number will be recorded and at the end of the chute each contestant will receive a contestant place card. These cards should be turned into you, the coach, immediately.
- 4. The coach will print the name of the runner and his school on the card.
- 5. Then record the information on the coaches team score envelope.
- 6. As soon as all runners on a team have finished, the coach should collect the contestants' place cards and turn them into the CHECKER in the basement of the Pro Shop.
- 7. The checker will check the score envelope at Station 4 and then turn it over to Station 5 for an adding machine check.
- 8. Station 6 will be the head scorer for the team races. Your score will be posted and your scoring envelope will be kept.
- 9. All coaches for team race will receive IBM labels before the race in their packets. The team races' IBM label will not be filled out and may be printed as per sample: 19 Jacobs, Steve Worthington. Individual race contestant's RBM labels will be completed before the race.
- 10. Place labels on appropriate score board in box representing place runner finished. We will write in times and post outside Club House.
- 11. Regardless of how a team finishes, all coaches should take their finish place slips to the scorer's table.
- 12. Coaches of contestants in individual race should post labels of their runner's name and school which are to be placed on individual race scoreboard.
- 13. As soon as all teams' scores have been totaled, the championship and runner-up teams will be declared.
- 14. Finish of the individual race will be posted. All individuals will be presented awards immediately after their race.
- 15. As soon as results are posted, team awards will be presented.
- 16. Commissioner Myer and Assistant Commissioner George Bates of the Ohio High School Athletic Association will present awards.
- 17. Results will be mailed Wednesday. Constructive criticisms are always welcome.
