Rowland, Petrey capture FC cross country crowns

Cats, Riders collect team titles at meet

ASHLAND — A freshman Western Reserve girl and a junior New London boy won the Firelands Conference cross country races Saturday morning to lead their respective teams to conference championships.

New London's Chris Rowland nipped junior Chris Nickoli of Western Reserve by one second (16:53-16:54) for the win. Rowland, who said he has a friendly rivalry with the Roughrider, took a wide lead early, but Nickoli closed the gap in the end.

It was the sixth time Rowland and Nickoli have matched up this season, and the Wildcat has one five of them. They'll meet again this Saturday in the district meet at Galion.

"This is the first time I ran on this course (at Ashland Crestview High School) and that slowed me down some," Rowland said.

Rowland called the win "just another weekend toward state."

The state meet is apparently what the whole team is pointing toward.

Senior Ravi Sharma (17:24), who was the third Wildcat in the top four finishers said, "That right! We're going to state," as he went through the chute at the finish line.

Junior Bobby Hunter placed third with a time of 17:13. Other New London runners were: sophomore Abe Dvorak (10th, 17:51); freshman Keith Landis (11th, 17:51); sophomore Steve Mason (19th, 18:51); and sophomore Brad Crawford (21st, 18:57).

It was the 12th boys' FC cross country championship for New London, according to school Principal Jim Van Sickle.

The Wildcats won 29-48 over Western Reserve. Mapleton was third (68 points), followed by Crestview (88), Plymouth (133), Black River (172) and St. Paul (174).

Behind Nickoli for the Roughriders were: senior Steve Mahl (fifth, 21:31); freshman Kevin Larson (seventh, 17:42); senior Tyler Carp (15th, 18:31); sophomore Eric Yetter (20th, 18:52); freshman Jeremy

In contrast to the boys' race, Western Reserve's Michelle Petrey led her team to the championship with a victory of almost a minute. Her time of 20:05 was 59 seconds better than sophomore teammate April Nickoli's.

Five of the top ten finishers were Lady Riders. Junior Paulette Brookover was fourth (21:12), followed by junior Melisa Beveridge (sixth, 21:48); sophomore Nicki Bores (ninth, 22:09); freshman Julie Welch (10th, 22:25); sophomore Paula Motolik (23rd, 23:50); sophomore Stephanie Butler (28th, 24:53) and junior Stacy Lierenz (30th, 25:26).

Western easily took the girls' crown 18-57 over New London. Plymouth was third (66 points) followed by Mapleton (115) and Black River (143).

"We expected to win the race," said Western coach Dave Rice. "We're a real young team. Who know's what we'll do in future years, but hopefully we'll do well next week at districts.

Petry "has been our No. 1 runner all year," the coach said, "and has done a tremendous job as a freshman."

Wildcat boys win Firelands crown

New London and Western Reserve were the big winners during the Firelands Conference cross country championships held Saturday morning at Crestview High School.

The Wildcats easily outdistanced Western Reserve to win the boys' FC title, placing five of the top 11 long-distance runners. Chris Rowland crossed the finish line first with a time of 16:53. Bobby Hunter (17:13) placed third, Ravi Sharma (17:24) was fourth, Abe Dvorak (17:51) was 10th, and Keith Landis (17:51) was 11th.

The boys' final team tallies found New London on top with 29 points, followed by Western Reserve (48), Mapleton (68), Crestview (88), Plymouth (133), Black River (172), and Norwalk St. Paul (174).

In the girls' action, Western Reserve placed six of the top 10 runners to easily run away with the FC crown. Western Reserve showed 18 points, followed by New London (57), Plymouth (66), Mapleton (115), and Black River (143).

Most of the area coaches were upbeat about the performances of their teams.

"I'm real pleased," said New London coach Bob Knoll. "We had five of the top 11 boys. We had been doing that in some invitationals this season, but not in the conference. We only get to do this once."

"It was a good day for us."

Kelly Gray (22:37), Dawn Gubeno (22:40), Sarah Dvorak (22:41), Chrissy Baer (22:43), and Sarah Harris (23:10) led New London's Ladycat squad to second-place finish.

The Mapleton boys placed five runners in the top 18 to lead the rest of the area's FC schools to a third-place finish behind Western Reserve.

Mapleton's top five boys were Mark Rohr (17:50), Erik Lautzenhiser (17:55), Eric Imhoff (18:19), Tim Teehan (18:37), and John Chacey (18:46). Rohr's time was ninth best.

Mapleton's top girls were Rochelle Ayers (22:53), Ginger Wile (23:33), Mindy McPike (24:25), Erica Nickoll (27:38), and Missy Floyd (45:00).

They ran pretty well," commented Mountie coach Kevin Smith. "They didn't have a real good day. The kids were pretty disappointed in their finish."

"I thought that John Chacey put forth a real good effort. He ran a good race and I'm really pleased with him."

Crestview coach Bob Staley was happy with his squad.

"I'm happy with the girls, definitely," said Staley. "The girls really did a nice job out there today."

"This is the first year that we have had a boys team," continued the coach. "I'm glad that we finished in the top four. We realistically knew

that we were not going to be able to stay with a New London."

Crestview's top dogs were Troy Gottfried (17:32), Rob Johnson (17:44), Tom McFadden (19:22), Jason Moore (19:32), and Steve Sprang (19:42) for the boys. Gottfried's time was good enough for sixth place.

Suzie Harraman (21:10) finished third for the Lady Cougars, with Charlotte Kuhn (21:50) finishing seventh.

Top runners for Black River were Jeremy Gannon (19:38), Alan Decoster (20:04), Bob Tanner (20:54), Brian Vincent (21:20), and Shane Yates (21:34) for the boys, with Amanda Walter (23:10), Jennifer Quast (23:40), Amanda Rook (25:39), Heidi Oberholtzer (26:04), and Jenni Boland (27:37) leading the way for the girls.

"This is the first year that we have had a girls team," said Black River coach Cynthia Lilly. "Of the six girls that ran, three of them ran their personal bests. I'm real pleased with that."

"For the most part, I'm happy with the boys," added Lilly. "Jeremy is my best runner, but he's got a bad knee so it wasn't his best time. Alan is just a freshman and his time was a personal best for him. He improves each time out. Vincent and Yates also recorded personal bests."

South Central didn't have enough runners to field a squad, but Darren Hunt (18:44) finished 17th to lead the three Trojan runners who participated in the meet. Brad Walcher (22:43) and Evgen Zagot (24:31) also competed for the Trojans.
