





# FAN EXPECTATIONS

It is the expectation of the Board of education that all spectators demonstrate sportsmanship towards players, coaches, game officials, and other fans.

Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to the following:

\* Threatening actions or verbal abuse of players, fans, coaches, and game

officials;

\* Unauthorized entry onto the playing area, team bench area or locker room;

\* Throwing objects, or disrespect toward anyone.

A fan who uses physical assault at an athletic contest will be prosecuted and denied admission to all future contests until he/she is reinstated by the district superintendent.

Written notification will be given to the offendant, stating the offense and resulting consequences. The fan may appeal the decision to the Board of Education or its designee, by notifying the appropriate Athletic Director within 5 working days of receipt of his/her notification letter.

An athletic contest is not a place for alcoholic beverages. People wishing to drink or those obviously under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave the premises.

## ADMISSION POLICY

Ticket prices for football, volleyball, basketball, and wrestling are \$4.00 adults and \$3.00 students. Reserve football and middle school events are \$2.00 adults and \$1.00 students.

Family passes are available for \$160.00 or \$60.00 for an individual pass. Senior citizens' individual passes are \$50.00. These passes are good for all high school and middle school home contests.

Full admission price for students and adults will be charged through the start of the fourth quarter. There will be no passes out, anyone leaving will pay full price for readmission.

# Plymouth High School Expectations and Responsibilities of Sportsmanship

A Goal For Everyone

### The Player

- 1. Treats opponents with respect.
- 2. Plays hard, but plays within the rules.
- Exercises self-control at all times, setting the example for others to follow.
- Respects officials and accepts their decisions without gesture or argument.
- 5. Wins without boasting, loses without excuses, and never quits.
- Always remembers that it is a privilege to represent the school and community.

### The Coach

- 1. Treats own players and opponents with respect.
- 2. Inspires in the athletes a love for the game and the desire to compete fairly.
- 3. Is the type of person he/she wants the athletes to be.
- 4. Disciplines those on the team who display unsportsmanlike behavior.
- 5. Respects the judgment and interpretation of the rules by the officials.
- Knows he/she is a teacher and understands the athletic arena is a classroom.

### The Official

- Knows the rules and their interpretations.
- 2. Places welfare of the participants above all other considerations.
- Treats players and coaches courteously and demands the same from them.
- Works cooperatively with fellow officials, timers and/or scorers for an efficient contest.
- Is fair and firm in all decisions, never compensating for a previous mistake.
- 6. Maintains confidence, poise and self-control from start to finish.

### The Spectator

- Attempts to understand and be informed of the playing rules.
- 2. Appreciates a good play no matter who makes it.
- 3. Cooperates with and responds enthusiastically to cheerleaders.
- Shows compassion for an injured player; applauds positive performances; does not heckle, jeer or distract players, and avoids use of profane and obnoxious language and behavior.
- Respects the judgment and strategy of the coach and does not criticize players or coaches for loss of a game.
- Respects property of others and authority of those who administer the competition.
- Censures those whose behavior is unbecoming.
