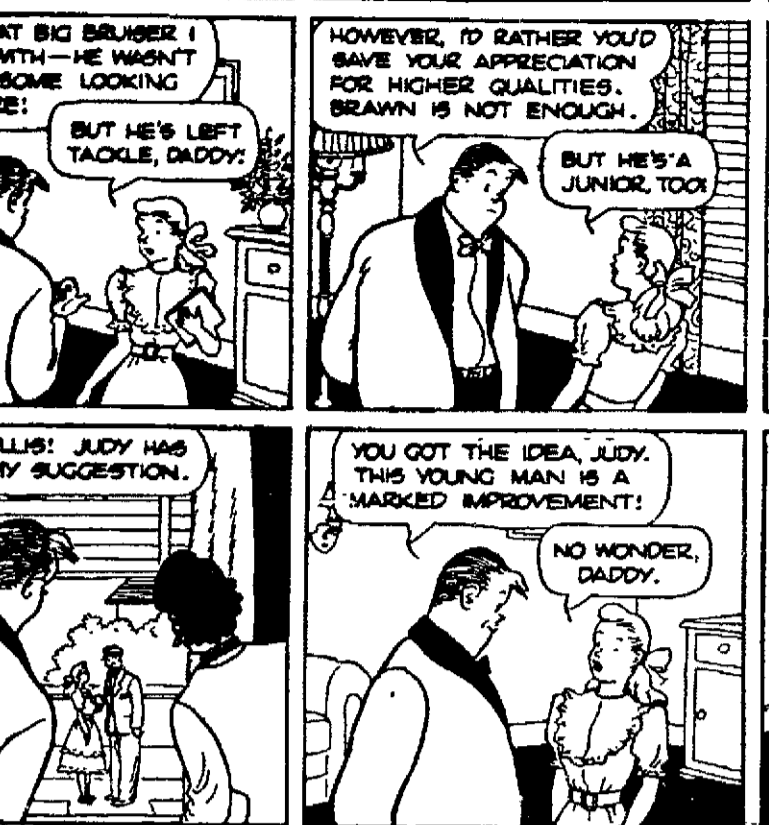

### Plymouth Grid Team Wins 1st Contest, 20-6

PLYMOUTH — Plymouth high school's first football team in many years garnered its initial 1948 victory yesterday afternoon by defeating the Willard reserves, 20 to 6.

Coach Dick McMillen's aggregation lost its first two games. The Pilgrims play the New London Wildcats at Plymouth next Saturday.

In the first quarter, Plymouth drove to the Willard seven before its passing attack stalled. Willard marched on to the 16 but a penalty put the ball on the one. Tim Burrer blocked the Willard punt for a safety.

Des. Donnenwirth's passes accounted for two scores and set up the third. He connected for 20 yards to Hubert Metcalf in the first play of the second quarter and tossed 30 yards to Bobby Schreck for the third.

A Donnenwirth-to-Don Cunningham 15 yarder set up the second tally. Trauger bucked over All three Harvey Wilson placement tries were blocked. The last half of the game was played in a steady drizzle.

Buckingham swept eight yards for the lone Willard tally.

### Michigan Romps to 16th Straight Football Victory

ANN ARBOR, Mich. — (AP) — Michigan ground out its 16th straight football victory here yesterday, 14 to 0, in the face of an Oregon air attack that threatened down to the last second.

Michigan showed 65,800 fans a determined and aggressive ball club in cracking the eight-game victory streak of the visiting Webfeet.

But the fans who helped open Michigan's 1948 home season were kept constantly on edge by the ever dangerous Oregon passer, Norm Van Brocklin.

Michigan muffed two chances and Oregon one before the Michigan offense caught fire long enough to send veteran end Dick Rifenburg over for the first counter, midway in the third period.

After moving 33 yards to their own 40 yard stripe, the Wolverines' talented sophomore tailback, Charley Ortman, smacked Rifenburg with a 35-yard pass and Rifenburg raced home.

Michigan cut loose again late in the third period, moving 82 yards for the game's only other counter.
