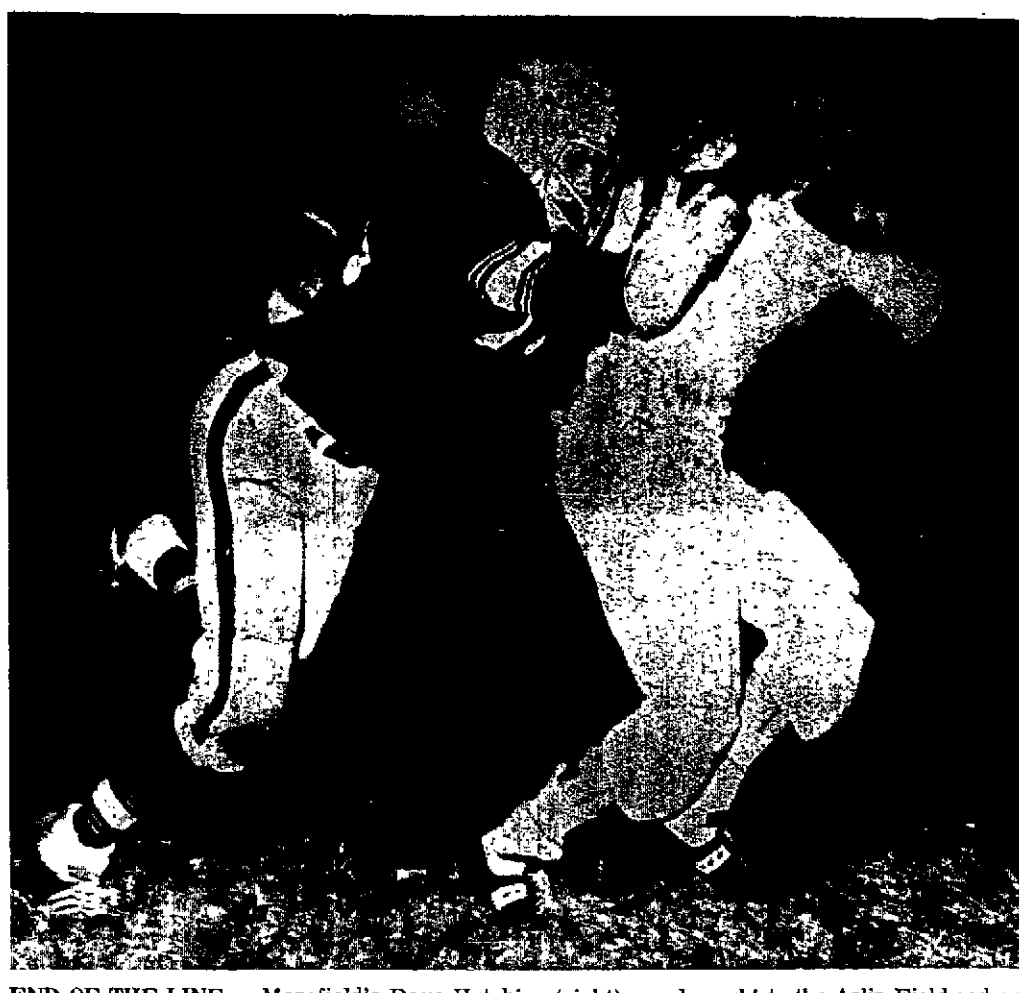
Elyria High Wins Buck Loop Title

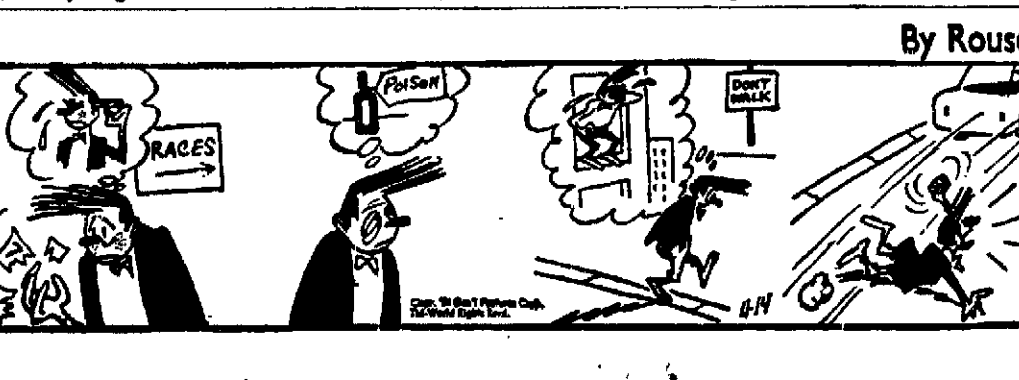
