# FAN EXPECTATIONS

It is the expectation of the Plymouth-Shiloh Board of Education that all spectators demonstrate sportsmanship towards players, coaches, game officials, and other fans.

Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to the following:

- \*Threatening actions or verbal abuse of players, fans, coaches, and game officials.
- \*Unauthorized entry onto the playing area, team bench area or locker room.
- \*Throwing objects, or disrespect toward anyone.

A fan who uses physical assault at an athletic contest will be prosecuted and denied admission to all future contests until he / she is reinstated by the District Superintendent.

Written notification will be given to the offender, stating the offense and resulting consequences. The fan may appeal the decision to the Board of Education or its designee, by notifying the appropriate Athletic Director within 5 working days of receipt of his / her notification letter.

An athletic contest is not a place for alcoholic beverages. People wishing to drink or those obviously under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave the premises.
