



Fan Expectations

It is the expectation of the Plymouth-Shiloh Board of Education that all spectators demonstrate sportsmanship towards players, coaches, game officials, and other fans.

Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to the following:

- · Threatening actions or verbal abuse of players, fans, coaches, and game officials.
- · Unauthorized entry onto the playing area, team bench area or locker room.
- Throwing objects, or disrespect toward anyone.

A fan who uses physical assault at an athletic contest will be prosecuted and denied admission to all future contests until he /she is reinstated by the District Superintendent.

Written notification will be given to the offendant, stating the offense and resulting consequences. The fan may appeal the decision to the Board of Education or its designee, by notifying the appropriate Athletic Director within 5 working days of receipt of his / her notification letter.

An athletic contest is not a place for alcoholic beverages. People wishing to drink or those obviously under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave the premises.

Firelands Conference Sportsmanship Policy

As a spectator, I will

- Cheer for my team, not against my opponent.
- Not use profane or inappropriate language.
- · Treat the game as a game not a war.
- Lead positive cheers in a positive manner.
- Applaud the efforts of both teams at games end.
- · Show concern for an injured player regardless of team.
- · Demand sportsmanlike behavior from those fans near me.
- Depart the game in a dignified and ethical manner.
- · Respect the official's judgment at all times.
- · Understand that my admission does not excuse my behavior.

The following are considered UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIORS and SUBJECT TO SANCTION ranging from WARNINGS to DISMISSAL and SUBSEQUENT SUSPENSION FROM ATTENDANCE.

As a spectator, I will NOT

- Use profanity, taunt, trash talk, or heckle our opponents, and coaches, the officials, our team and coaches, or other spectators.
- Wear derogatory or offensive attire.
- Enter the playing surface before, during or after the contest.
- At any time throw any objects or projectiles.





PLYMOUTH ATHLETICS ON-CAMPUS COMPLEX PROJECT

Our goal is to establish an athletic complex on Plymouth-Shiloh school grounds which could host football games, track events, graduation, and remain open for community use.

While we are beginning to play football at the new field this fall, it is important that everyone know we are not finished with the project. We are in need of continual support both financially and the volunteering of community members. It is a great opportunity to get involved and pay it forward to current and future Plymouth students and community for generations to come.

Where We Started: Over the years, a field house with home locker room and weight room, scoreboard and field goal posts were added.

What Athletic Boosters Has Accomplished in the Last Year:

- Built Press Box - \$45,000

- Home and Away Bleachers - \$86,000

- Concrete Pads - \$13,000

- Fencing - \$10,000

- Concession Building - \$7,500

- Ticket Booth - \$1,200

Plymouth-Shiloh Board of Education:

- Lighting System \$138,000
- Sound System (coming in September) \$20,000

Complete Complex Needs:

- Restroom/Concession/Locker Room Building \$100,000+
- Electric/Plumbing to buildings-??
- All Weather Track \$300,000
- Additional Fencing \$40,000
- 25 second clocks \$5,000
- Landscaping, etc. \$15,000

Contributions:

- In the last year, Athletic Boosters have received over \$75,000 in private donations, most coming from Plymouth alumni.
- Boosters has also received \$42,000 from local businesses including \$25k from Phillips Mfg. in Shelby, an
 additional pledge of \$25k for next year, and offered to match any donations towards this project.

Recognition:

Private contributors will be recognized at the entrance of the field on a brick walkway (coming 2016). Businesses will receive advertising options. Advertisement options and naming rights are dependent on amount of contribution.
