

Tri-County Meet Won By Simpson

John Simpson Junior High School racked up 67 1/2 points at Mehack Field yesterday en route to capturing the ninth annual Tri-County League track meet.

The Bulldogs scored five victories in the five-team meet, which saw only one record collapse. Cubby Baker of Johnny Appleseed pole vaulted 11 feet, 7 3/4 inches to eclipse the old mark of 11-6 set by Dan Willard, also of Appleseed, in 1969. Baker also scored a triumph in the 440-yard dash, covering the distance in 56.5 seconds.

The Pioneers finished second in the meet, accumulating 50 1/2 points, while Madison edged Ashland by 1/2 point to secure third-place honors.

Britisher In Popular Triumph

LONDON (UPI) — Graham Hill, the 42-year-old veteran of British motor racing, gained one of his most popular victories Saturday when he won the International Trophy Race at Silverstone.

It was his first major Formula One victory since the accident in the United States in 1969 when he broke both legs.

New Zealand's Chris Amon was second in a Matra and Brazil's Emerson Fittipaldo third in a Lotus.

Misfortune struck many drivers. Jackie Stewart who pulverized the field in the first part of the race, crashed on the first lap of the second half. He was unhurt.

Jim Hunt in a March 713 touched the Brabham of Brazil's newcomer Jose Ferreira at 100 miles per hour and both cars ran off the track and crashed. Both drivers walked away unhurt.

Swedish driver Ronnie Peterson crashed at high speed in his March very early in the race and was detained in a hospital with a concussion.

Arsenal Gains Rare English Soccer Double

LONDON — Arsenal's magnificent Gunners did what only three other English soccer teams have done in history — they won the elusive league-cup "double" at Wembley Stadium here Saturday before 100,000 fans.

Arsenal beat Liverpool, 2-1, in extra time and won the Football Association Cup. Put with the First Division league championship they won last Monday, it gave the Gunners the "double."

The Gunners are only the second team this century to win the double. Cross-town rival Tottenham Hotspur clinched it just 10 years ago. Oddly enough, Spurs were the team Arsenal beat a week ago for the league title.
