

The 1974 OHSAA State Track Meet and this program are dedicated to Mr. Fred Beekman who has coordinated the State Track Meet for Twenty-Five years.

Fred Beekman joined the staff of The Ohio State University in 1948 as assistant director of recreation and intramurals. He held that position until 1963 when he was appointed Director, succeeding Leo Staley.

As Director, Beckman oversees one of the largest and most extensive college intramural programs in the country. Last year alone, more than 50,000 students took part in a recreational activity or belonged to one of the many intramural teams at Ohio State. Under Beekman's supervision the program has expanded to 27 different activities offered during the academic year.

Over the years Beekman has also been actively involved in officiating (on all levels) as well as other sports related activities.

For 25 years now the widely respected Beckman has served as meet manager of the Ohio State Track Relays. Along those lines, the 1942 graduate of Ohio State has also coordinated the Ohio High School Track Championships the past quarter of a century and both meets are considered among the best in the
