Ontario High Wins In JAC

LOUDONVILLE — Ontario High School pulled a mild upset and walked off with the fifth annual Johnny Applesseed Conference track-field meet championship last night at the Loudonville High oval with a 55-point total.

The Warriors have now won the meet every other year since its inception. They are previous JAC meet victors in 1963 and 1961.

Favored Loudonville was second, but a distant 15 points off the Ontario pace.

Only one meet record fell. It was broken by John Casler of Crestview, which finished third with a good 36-point showing.

Casler was a double winner as he won the shot put with just under the record distance and then surpassed Ontario's Pat McMahon's discus record of 145 feet, 1 1/2 inches as he tossed the platter 146 feet, 6 1/2 inches.

There were three other double winners, two of whom contributed importantly to the Warriors' victory.

Larry Easterday and Dave Hersh of Ontario took their respective specialties. Easterday won both hurdling events and Hersh took the mile and 800-yard run.

Additionally, Mike Ruckman of Plymouth, who won three firsts at the Mansfield district meet last week, won two dash events — the 100 and 220-yard sprints.

In addition to helping themselves to four individual firsts, the Warriors won the mile relay and also took three second places and three thirds.

Plymouth finished fourth with 26 points mainly on the merits of Ruckman's showing.
