

# WHS Track Team Wins Last Two Meets of 1969 Season

The Willard high school track team closed the season on a triumphant note last week by winning a pair of dual meets.

The WHS thincads downed Plymouth 72-55 here Thursday and the Flashes beat Bellevue 68½ to 59½ on the loser's track Friday.

## A Winning Hand

Coach Terry Adams didn't use his two aces, Chuck Barrison and Tim King, in the Plymouth meet but three eights proved to be the winning hand for Willard. The Flashes landed eight firsts, eight seconds, and eight thirds in the meet.

Adams held King out of action against Plymouth to have his distance star in top form for the league meet with Bellevue the following day.

Adams chose not to use Barrison in either the Plymouth or Bellevue meets. The flashy sprinter has been bothered for over a week by a slightly pulled thigh muscle, and with the Regional Meet on tap for Saturday, the second year coach was taking every precaution to have his top sprinter at peak efficiency for the Regional.

## Dual Winner

In the Plymouth meet sophomore Fred Barrison was the lone double winner. Barrison won the century in 10.6 and the 220 with a time of 23.1.

Other Willard firsts were Paul Coburn, shot, 46-11½; Kevin Adams, discus, 122-7; Bill Grossman, pole vault, 11-0; Logan Sexton, 440, 57.0; Don Wilson, 120 yard low hurdles, 15.2; and the four lap relay team of Cliff Dalton, Mike Dalton, Bill Grossman and Gary Click, 1:38.2.

Coach Adams used a host of underclassmen in the meet and they stood up well in their first varsity competition. On the strength of the Plymouth meet the future looks bright for WHS in track for several years.

## Beat Bellevue

At Bellevue the Flashes grabbed nine firsts, six seconds, and seven thirds.

Tim King and Bill Grossman were double winners for Willard.

King won the mile in 4:47 and the durable distance runner came back to capture the 880 with a time of 2:11. Grossman cleared 11-0 to win the pole vault and the versatile junior won the 440 in 54.0.

Grossman was also a member of Willard's winning mile relay team. The foursome of Grossman, Cliff Dalton, Logan Sexton, and

Randy Moore won the mile relay in a new WHS record time of 3:41.3.

Fred Barrison tied Bellevue's fleet Tom Nation for first place in the 100 yard dash. Both boys were clocked in 10.9. Barrison also ran on Willard's winning 880 yard relay team of Jerry Heckman, Don Wilson, and Cliff Dalton which won with a time of 1:37.2.

Other Willard winners were Paul Coburn in the shotput with a toss of 48-8 ¾ and Charlie Wyandt in the discus with a throw of 127-0.
