

Ada Captures Sectional Title

avored defending champion Columbus Grove lived up to its advance billing with a lop-sided victory in the Class A sectional track meet Saturday. The Bulldogs nearly doubled the score on second-place McComb, 120-63, despite the rain.

McComb's Ned Tate, defending champ in both the 100 yard dash and the 220, repeated in both events, but failed to equal last year's efforts in Saturday's rain.

Records were set in the 880-yard run, wht two-mile run, and the high jump, and Doug Henderson of Columbus Grove tied the pole vault record of 12-6 by Leipsic's Paul MacDonell. All records are from 1971, the first season with separate meets for the three classes.

Ft. Jennings' Eill Menke sliced the two-mile record from 10:16.3 to 10:03. The 1971 record was set by Mark Tyson of Elmwood. Mark's brother, Ken, also bettered last year's record, finishing second in 10:11.8.

Kevin Latham of Cory-Rawson beat defending champion Chris Diller from Liberty-Benton in the 880, lowering Diller's record of 2:05.2 to 2:04.9. Diller finished third.

Defending champion Doug Tavenner of Columbus Grove won the mile and finished second in the 880.
