But "fantastic" Jim Fantozz, the Streaks' junior hurdles ace will be on hand. He copped the highs at Mansfield and is a prohibitive favorite to repeat in the BC.

The meet, directed by Marion track coach Gary Warner, is to get under way at 10:30 a.m. for preliminaries. Finals start at 1 o'clock.
