

Shelby Whippets Swamp Plymouth

SHELBY — The Shelby Whippets took 13 out of a possible 15 first places to dump the Plymouth Big Red, 100 to 27, in a dual track meet here yesterday.

The meet originally had been set up as a triangular meet with Crestline to take part, but rainy and cold weather caused a postponement from April 10, Crestline was unable to take part yesterday.

Three Whippets were double winners: Dave Merritt, who won the high jump with five feet, 10 inches, and the 120 - yard high hurdles in 16.9 seconds; Dave Witchey, who won the mile run in 4:54.5 and the 880 - yard run in 2:11.6; and Rich Steele, who won the 440 - yard dash in 53.5 seconds and the pole vault with 11 feet, 6 inches.

The Whippets swept all three places in the high jump, pole vault, 120 - yard high hurdles, 100 - yard dash, 180 - yard low hurdles and 220 - yard dash.

Malabar Beats Two Schools

The Falcons of Malabar High School outpointed two other teams yesterday to come out on top of a three-way track meet at Mehock Field.

The Falcons garnered 92 points while Lexington had 45 and Clear Fork 22.

Andy Johnson, Terry Carter and Mike Watson each had double wins for Malabar. Johnson won the mile run in a blistering 4:28.3 and the 880-yard run in 2:04.9. Carter took the 100-yard dash (10.0) and 220-yard dash (22.9). Watson bested the competition in the shot put at 50 feet, three inches and in the discus at 173 feet, 8½ inches.

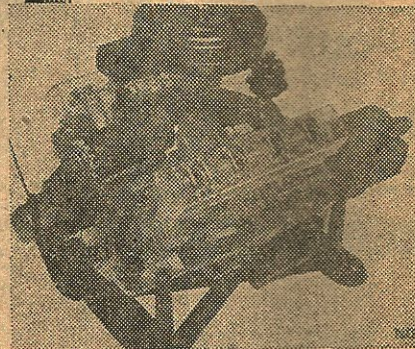
