### Lower Respect

When Gaylor Perry spouted off the other day, saying he instigated his own trade to the Texas Rangers last June by going to Indians president Ted Bonda, it sort of lowered the veteran pitcher in the eyes of some people.

What he said won't affect Manager Frank Robinson, with whom he had his biggest problem.

But it did place Bonda AND General Manager Phil Seghi in something of an embarrassing light, if you take Perry's word as the gospel. Bonda wouldn't add to it, but neither did he deny it.

Meanwhile, Seghi could only simmer. For him to say anything in rebuttal would only serve to keep Perry's words

on the sports pages. But inside, the Tribe's GM had to be more than a trifling upset.

It was a stab in the back by Perry to infer that Seghi doesn't pull the strings, even if it is partially true. The thing is, this Indians team is now close to 100 per cent the handiwork of Phil Seghi, and to take anything away from him with cheap cut-throat talk falls short of being a class guy.

So when the Tribe shells the old guy, 9-1, last Tuesday some of the sting of Gaylor's words were considerably less painful for Seghi when the next day's newspapers hit the stands.

### Reawakening

After too many years of futility, the Toledo Mudhens are causing a reawakening among dormant baseball fans there with a robust attack that has already produced 23 runs in one game and an 11-0 win in a game called after 5 1/2 innings because of rain.

The Indians, of course, are equally happy because Toledo is their new triple-A farm team.

If there is one area the parent club should be extra pleased about, but isn't, is right-handed pitcher Steve Kline. He has been outstanding in two starts with the Mudhens, including combining with Fred Beebe to shut out the Memphis Blues the other night.

However, Kline agreed to play with Toledo to test his surgically-resurrected right elbow and torn achilles tendon. Before the Indians can recall him this year, Kline would have to clear major league waivers, and if he's doing as well as Farm Director Bob Quinn says, that'll never happen.

A crowd of over 5,400 saw the Mudhens' home opener Friday night. Prior to the game, the Mudhens turned things around by holding a "Kangaroo Kourt" — a post-victory-only custom with the Indians — in which General Manager Charlie Singer was fined for wearing a "funeral-type" suit.

Afterward, a player — probably Joe Lis — remarked, "We don't want any undertakers around our ball club."
