



Lucas boys, Crestview girls victorious at conference track meet

LUCAS — Plymouth's Jamie Brooks put on a fine one-person show Saturday, but it wasn't quite enough to give Plymouth a title in the Black Fork Valley Conference girls track meet.

The Big Red girls fell short of champion Crestview in the conference get-together. The Cougars scored 59 team points to 51 for Plymouth and 33 for the Lucas Cubs.

In the boys half of the meet, Lucas made a shambles of the field, racking up 91½ points. Crestview was a distant runner-up with 48, while Plymouth registered 19½.

Brooks was victorious in the high jump (4-10), long jump (13-10½) and 100-meter low hurdles (18.0). Plymouth's girls also established a new BFVC record in the 880-yard relay with a 1:56.8 time.

For Plymouth's boys, Mike Beck was the lone first place finisher, winning the two-mile run with a meet record 10:35.0 time. Teammate Steve Nease was second in that event at 10:43.0.

Other high finishers for the Plymouth boys were Steve Jamerson, third in the high

jump (5-4) and fourth in the long jump (16-1); Beck, second in the mile (4:52.3); and James Will, third in the pole vault (11-6).

For the Big Red girls, Becky Turson was second in the high jump (5-4) and fourth in the long jump (16-1); Beck, second in the mile (4:52.3); and James Will, third in the pole vault (11-6).

For the Big Red girls, Becky Turson was second in the high jump (4-8), third in the long jump (12-10½) and was a member of the winning 440-yard relay team with Kim Daron, Lisa Daron and Paula Phillips (55.4). Fayette Hudson was second in the mile run (6:02.0) and fourth in the 880-yard run (3:03.0); Lisa Daron was second in the 220-yard dash (27.6) and third in the 100-meter dash (14.2); Montelle Levering was third in the 880-yard run (2:48.0); and Annette Takos came in third in the 440-yard run (1:08.3).

Other boys winners were Bob Buckler of Lucas in the 100-meter and 220-yard dashes; Jim Constance of Lucas in the 880-yard and mile runs; Andy Meyers of Lucas in the high jump, setting a meet recor-

d; Byron Banks of Lucas in the shot put; Mike Miller of Crestview in the pole vault, setting a meet record; Randy Napier of Crestview in the long jump; Troy Merle of Crestview in the 440-yard run, setting a meet record; Greg Meyers of Lucas in the 300-meter low hurdles, setting a meet record; the team of Mark VanTilburg, Greg Meyers, Curt Caldwell and Buckler of Lucas in the 440-yard relay; and the team of Caldwell, Constance, Andy Meyers and Greg Meyers of Lucas in the mile relay.

Other winners on the girls side were Maria Masters of Lucas, setting meet records in the shot put and discus; Theresa Jacobs of Crestview in the 100-meter and 220-yard dashes; Denise Crank of Crestview in the mile run; Lorraine Moore of Crestview in the 440-yard run, setting a meet record; Sherry Glenn of Crestview in the 880-yard run; and the mile and two-mile relay teams of Crank, Glenn, Kim Kocheiser and Debbie Swope of Crestview, setting meet records in both.
