

Molly Woodruff of South Central was a dual winner in the 1600 at 5:24.7 and the 800 at 2:23.0. Donell Branham of Plymouth was another double winner in the high jump at 4-8 and the low hurdles at 43.2.

Yet another two-time top finisher was Andrea Dudte of Mapleton in the 200 at 12.7 and the 400 in a new meet record 1:00.5. Dudte also ran on the Mounties top-placing 1600 relay team.

Plymouth added the 3200-meter relay to its list of firsts in a time 10:12.7.
