

PHS track squads rank near top at Tri-County

SYCAMORE—The Plymouth boys and girls track teams finished in the upper divisions of the six-team fields gathered at the Tri-County Meet hosted by Mohawk.

The Big Red tracksters wound up third with 115 points while the Lady Vikings finished as runners-up with 99 markers.

Ron Stephens had another stellar outing for PHS with firsts in the long jump (20-7½), high jump (5-8), 100-meter dash (11.3) and 200-meter dash (24.06).

Donell Branham ruled the 300-meter low hurdles for Plymouth in 50.6 seconds while the 3200-meter relay team of Susan Helms, Jenny Chase, Jenny Adkins and Kathy Welker were first in 10:49.2.
