

Big Red thinclads open season at Seneca East

The Plymouth boys track team placed fourth in the Tri-County meet at Seneca East Tuesday with 54 points, while the girls were fifth with 53.

The Big Red boys finished behind state-power Seneca East (199) and South Central and Mohawk (75).

Ryan Click won the 800-meter run with a time of 2:11.4, while Nick Keaton tied for second in the 100 dash and placed second in the 200 all alone.

Matt Anderson was third in the shot put and Mike Branham was sixth in the 100, fourth in the 200 and sixth in the high jump.

The 400 relay team of Click, Mike Blankenship, Keaton and Branham was second, while the 1,600 relay unit of Keaton, Blankenship, Anderson and Jay Follett was fourth.

In addition, Chad Kirkpatrick was sixth in the

300 hurdles and Follett was sixth in the 1,600.

On the girls side, Heather Roll was second in the 3,200 with a time of 14:28.5 and fourth in the 1,600.

Richelle Smart was second in the shot put with a throw of 32-feet, 7-inches and finished fourth in the 100 hurdles.

Kim Howard was third in the 100 hurdles and Alexis Sheely was placed fourth in the discus. Julie Chichock was fifth in the 100 and Stephanie Cunningham was fifth in the high jump. April Schwaderer was sixth in the 1,600 and Amy McClintock was sixth in the 800.

The relay team of Roll, Jenny Reber, McClintock and Schwaderer was third in the 3,200 and the quartet of Schwaderer, Smart, Niki Baker and Roll was fifth in the 1,600.
