

McKenzie, Collins pace Plymouth track teams

NEW WASHINGTON — Senior Mike McKenzie won both hurdle races and set a meet record in the process and helped Plymouth to a fourth-place finish at the Buckeye Central Invitational Tuesday.

McKenzie set a new record in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles as he won with a time of 41.44. Earlier in the meet, he captured the 110-meter high hurdles with a clocking of 15.66.

Ariel Collins was a record-setter for the Plymouth girls in the 1,600-meter run as she triumphed with an effort of 5:57.47.

Crestline ran away with the boys title and enjoyed a 44-point margin over runner-up Monroeville. In the girls competition, Monroeville shaded Buckeye Central 141-131 for the crown.
