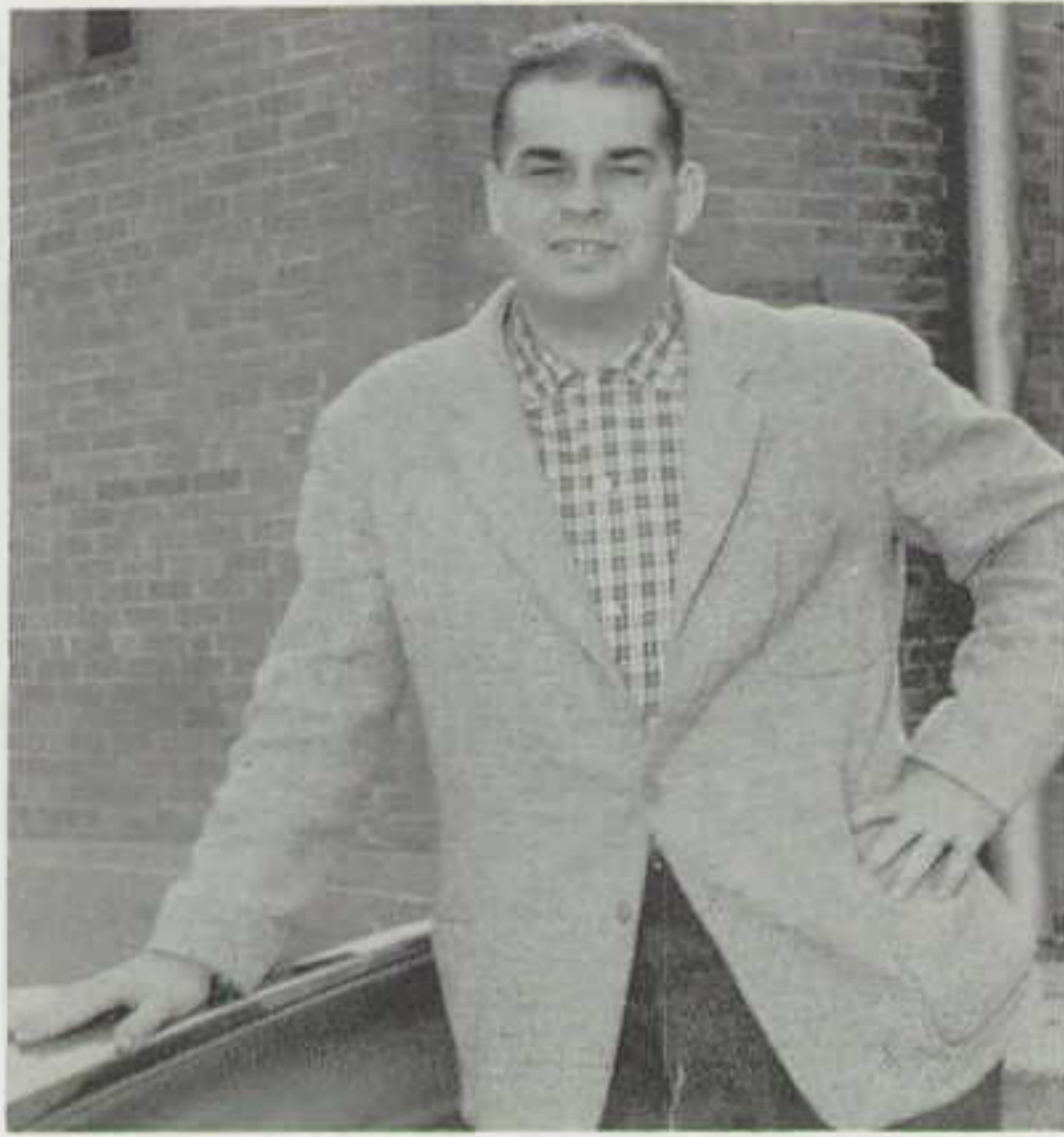

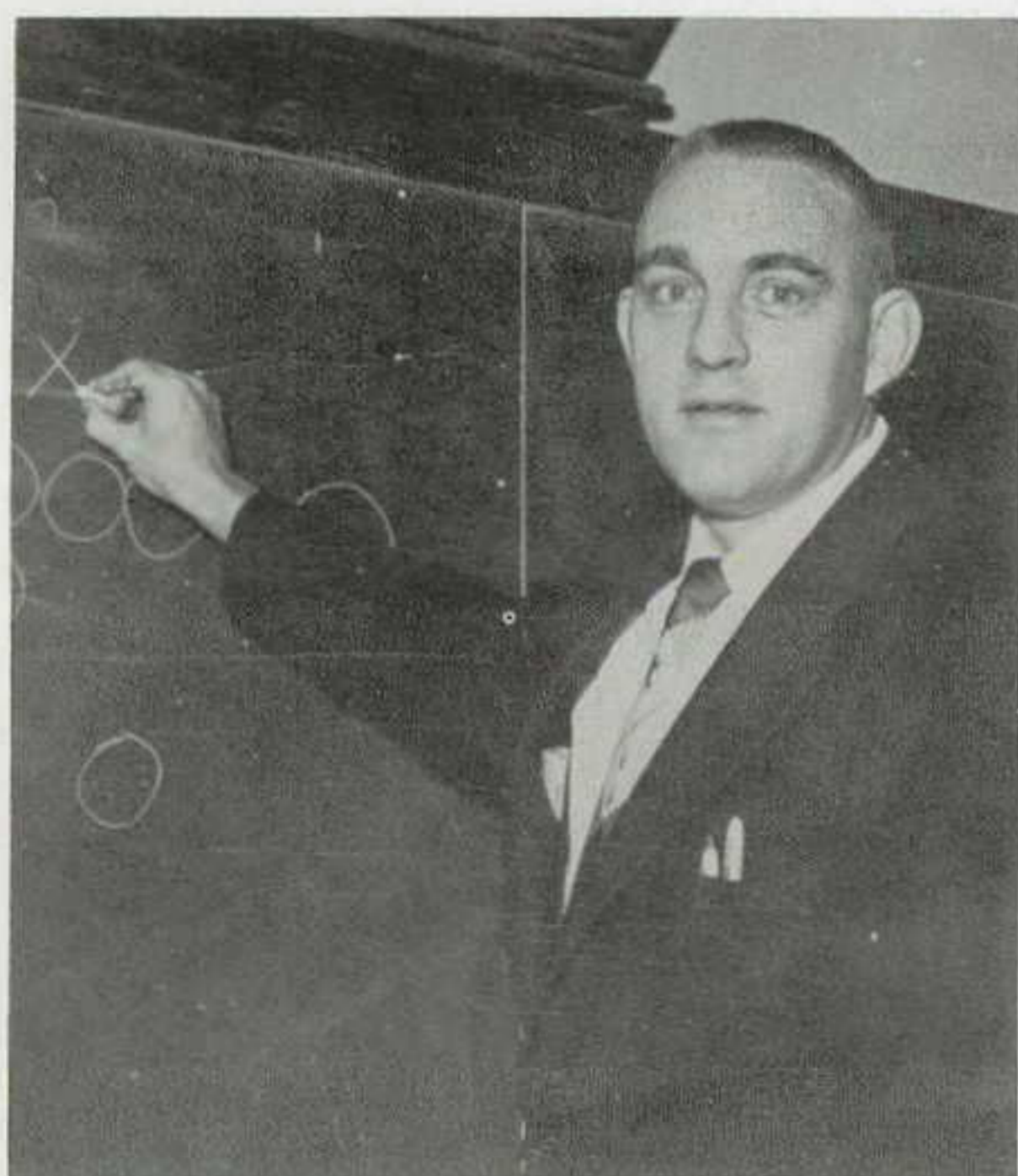

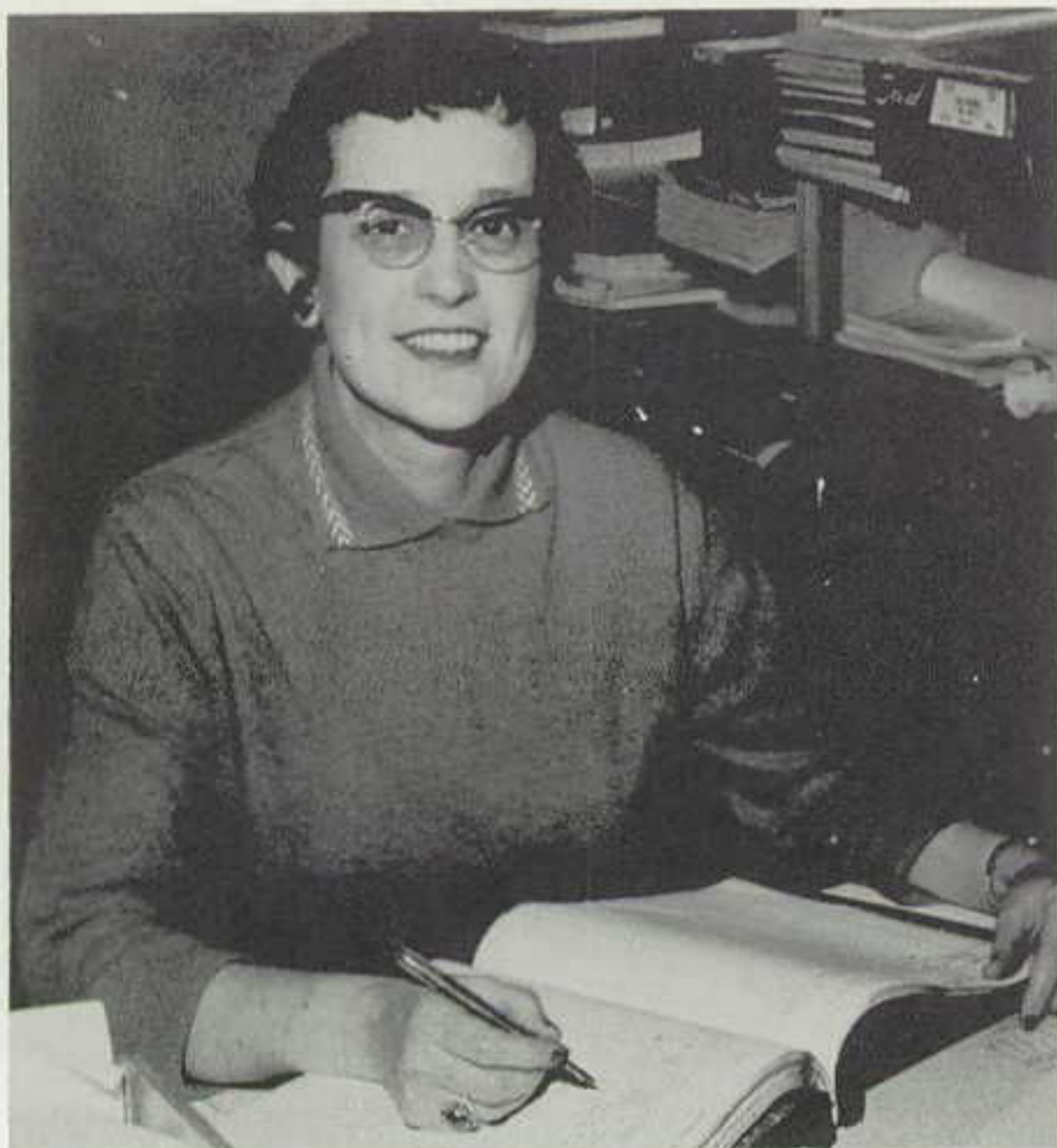

Mr. Strine: Well, everyone seemed to have a good time, don't you think so Miss Easterday?


Miss Easterday: Yes, I do. It's always rewarding to come to a class reunion and see what some of my former students have done with their lives.
