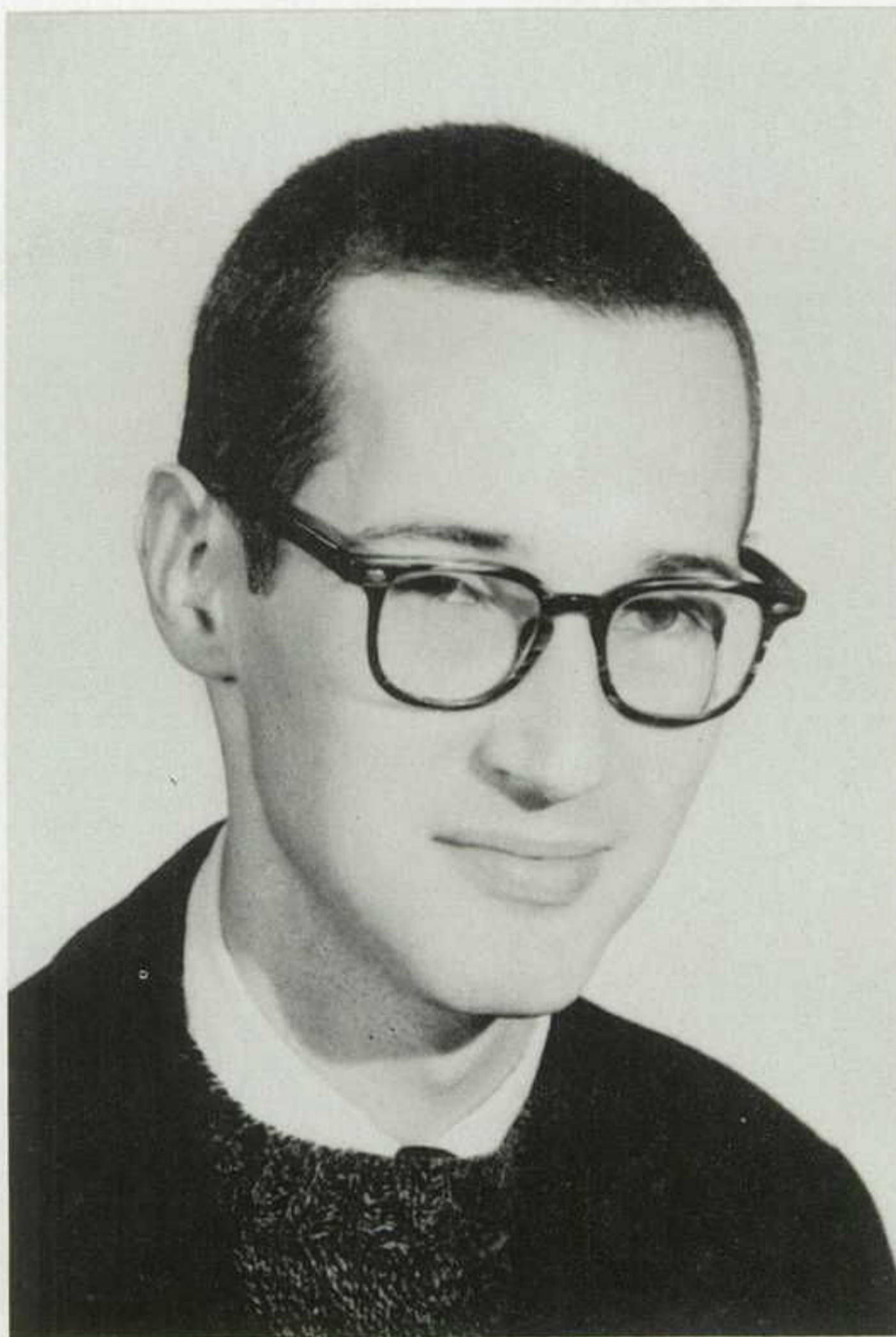

# DEDICATION



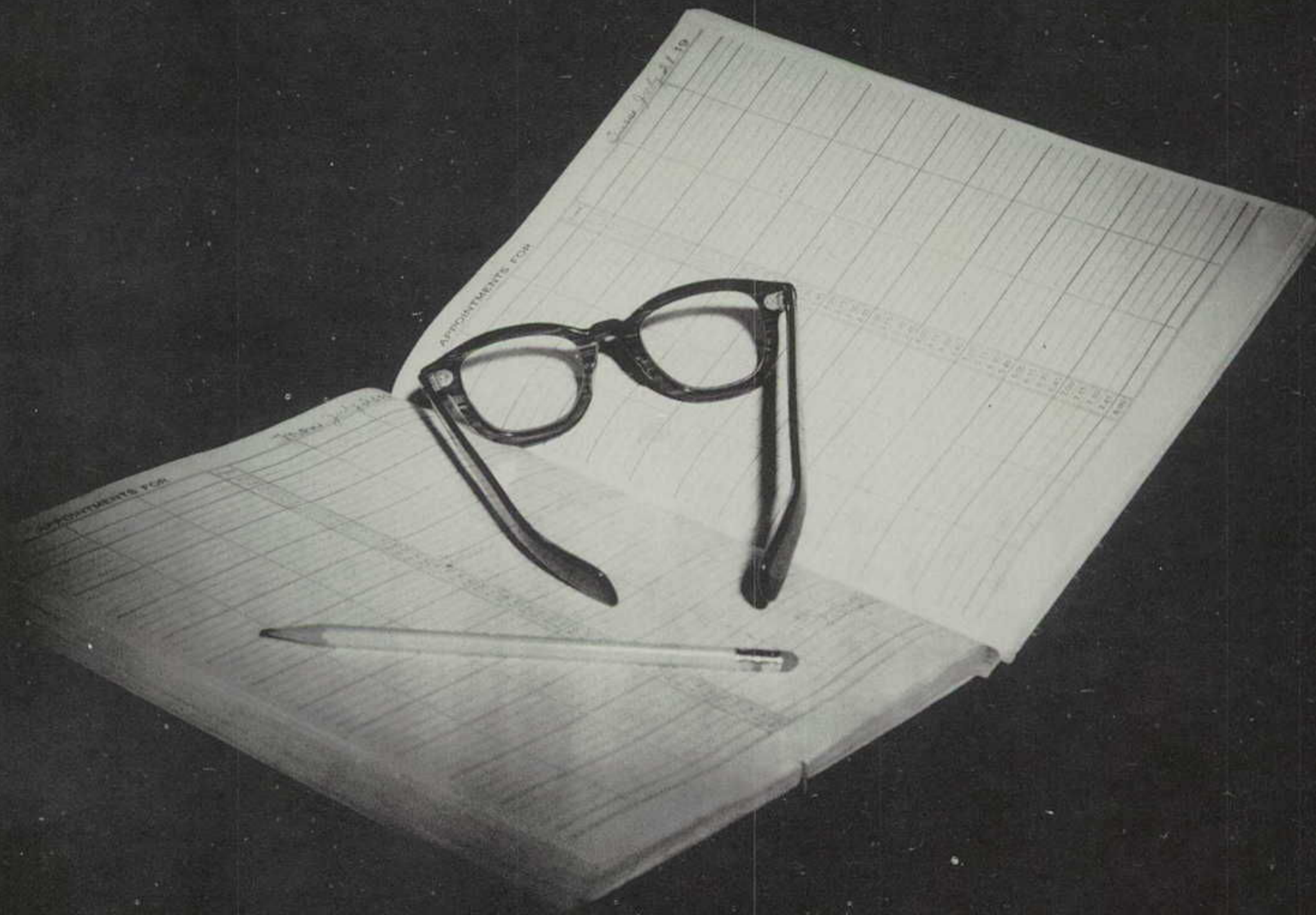


Mr. Guy Flora
