FOREWORD

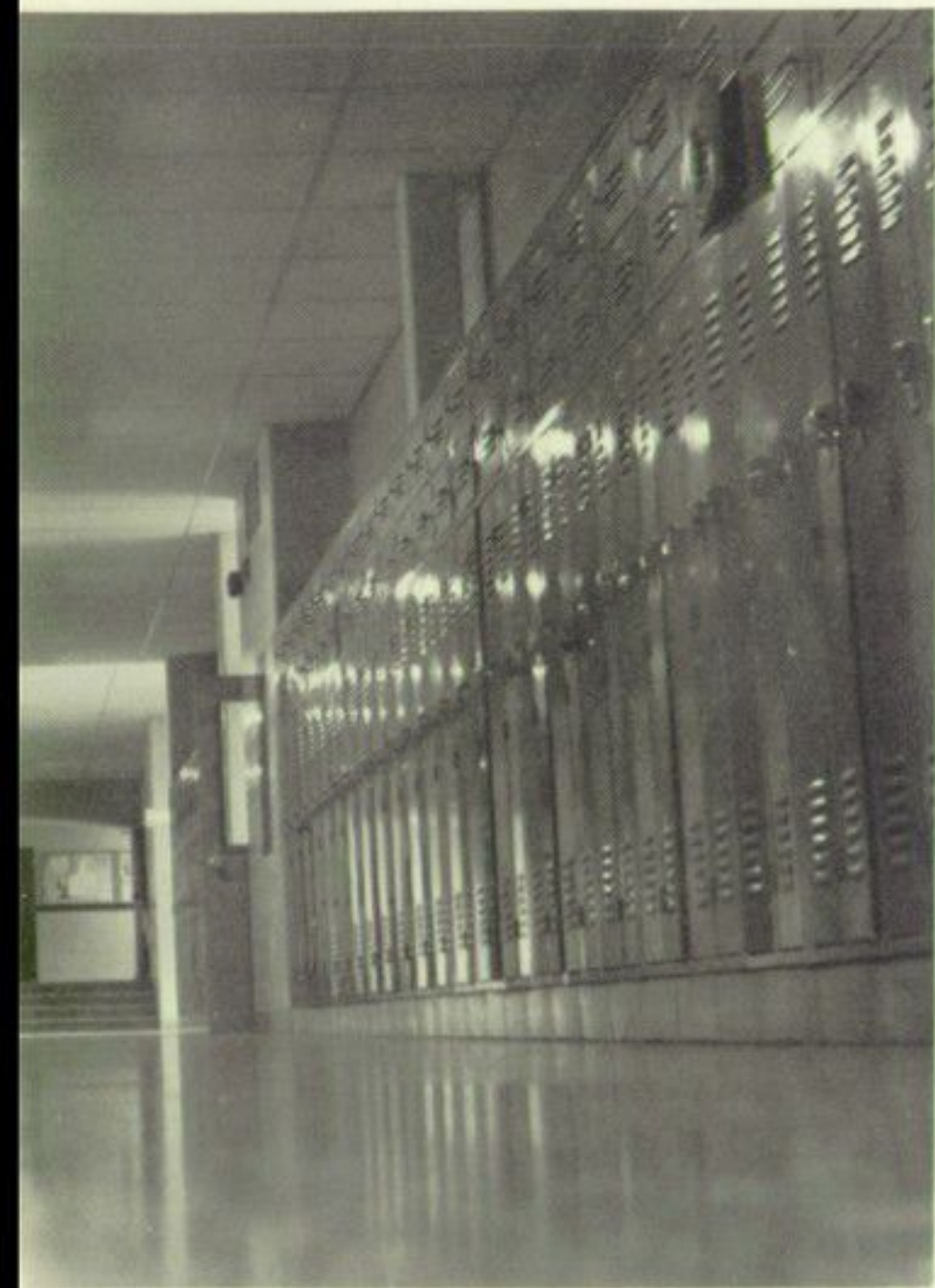

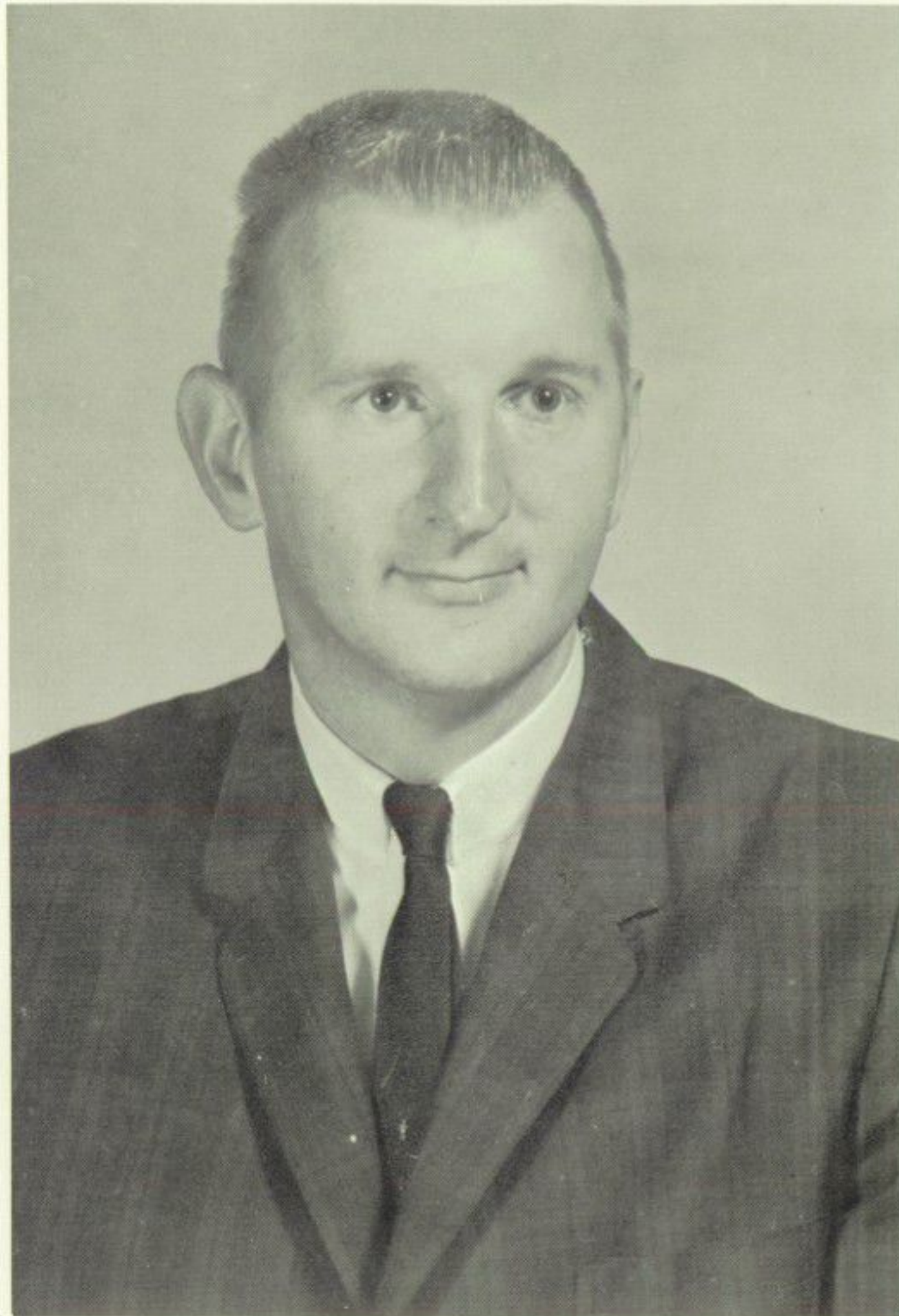
The enthusiasm shown in decorating the Senior rock, class rivalries, and that unmistakable union among the students at crucial moments.

He has contributed much to our basketball team and to our school. Last year he led the 1964 Basketball team to the Richland County League Championship.

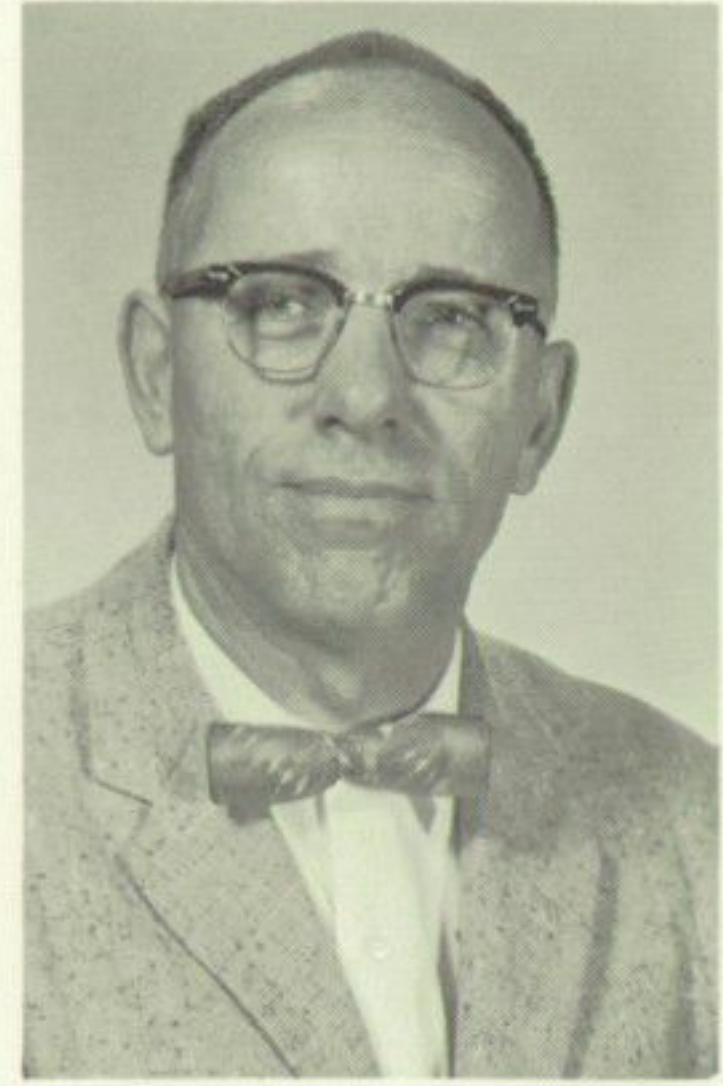
