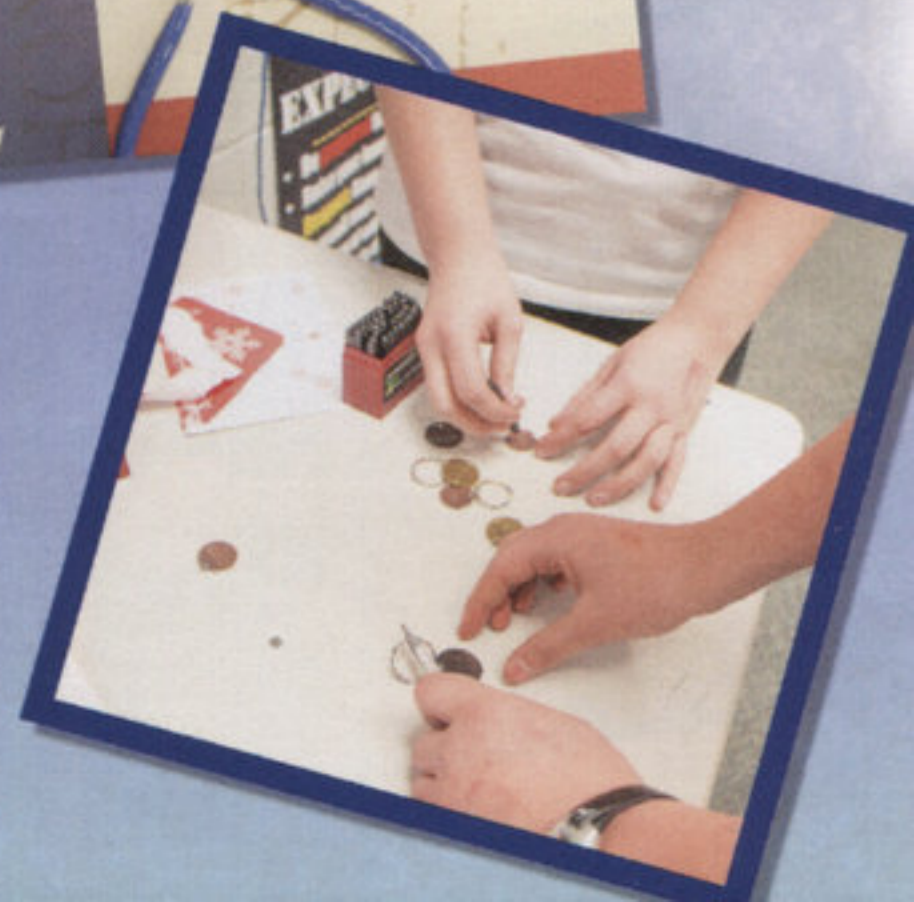


EIGHTH GRADERS

AUGUST 9 - A police shooting of 18 year old Michael Brown in Ferguson, MO, sparks a national debate on race.



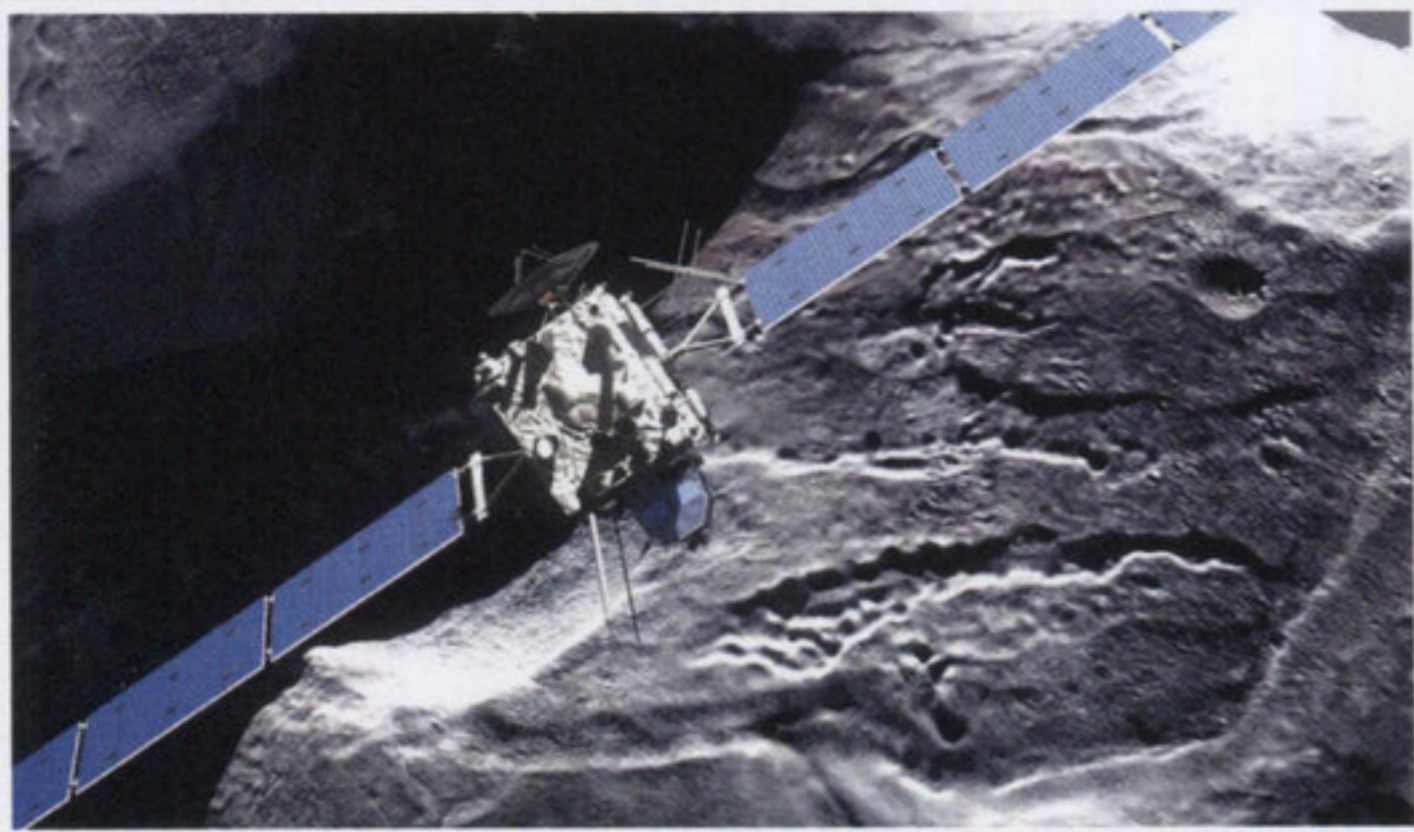
SEPTEMBER - Apple debuts larger iPhone 6 and announces upcoming Apple Watch.

FEBRUARY 22 - *Birdman*, starring Michael Keaton, wins Best Picture at the 87th Academy Awards.



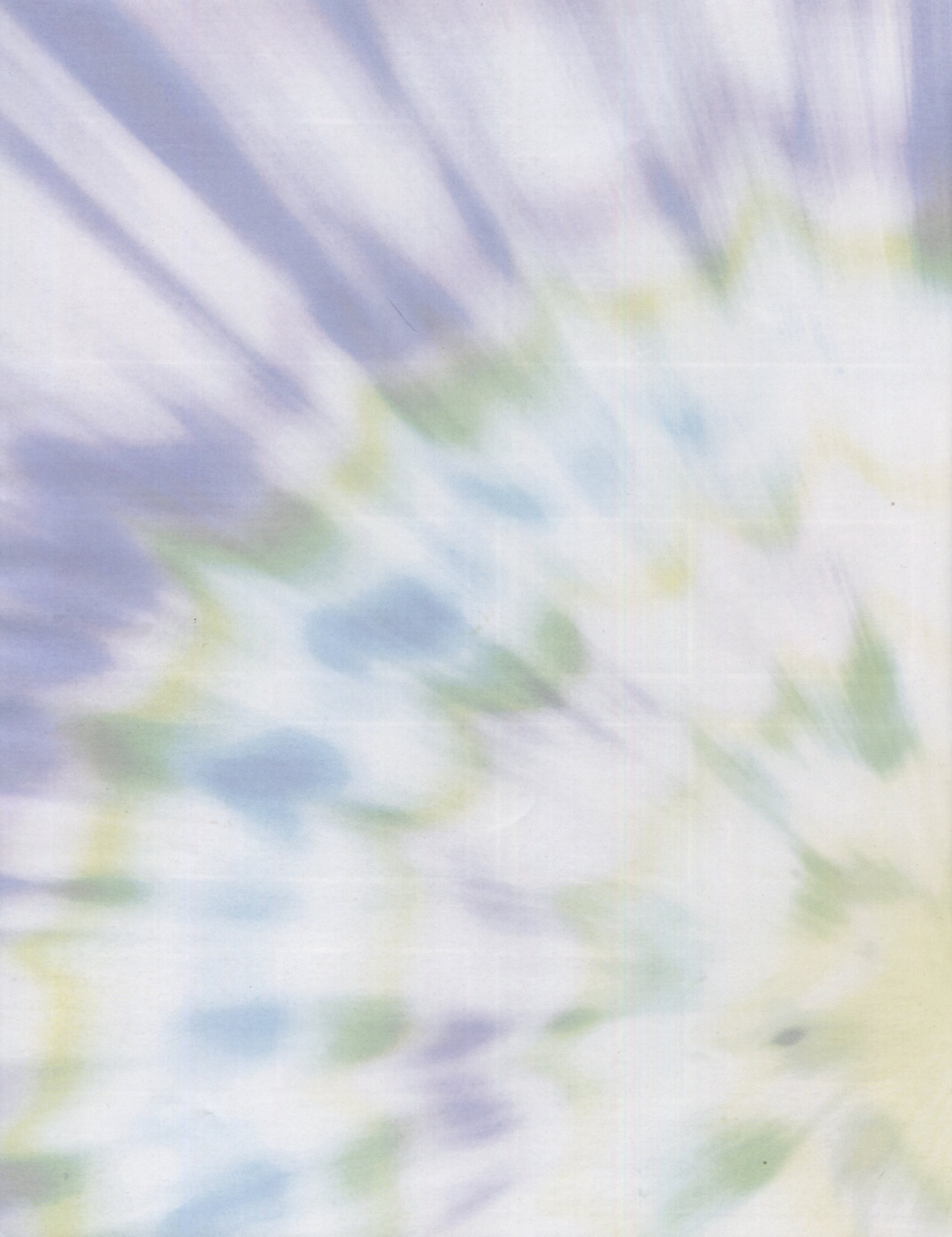
FEBRUARY 22 - Julianne Moore wins an Oscar for Best Actress for her role in *Still Alice*.
