MARCH - Congress passes a bill that mandates NASA to send humans to Mars by 2033.



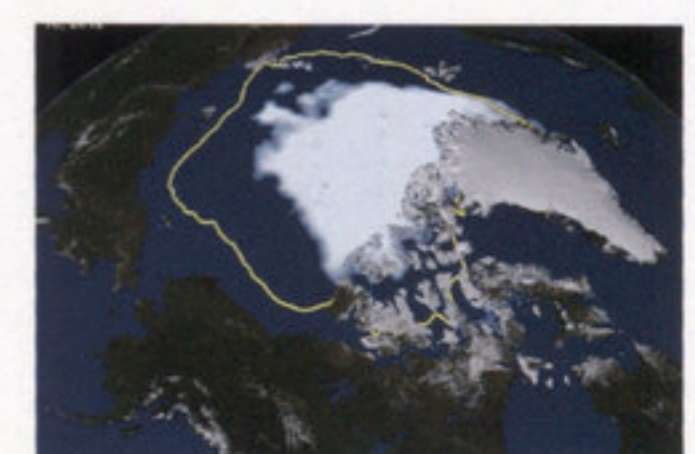
DECEMBER - 2016 becomes the hottest year on record with global temperatures breaking the record set in 2015.
